
How does the homeless population of Lawrence see themselves fitting in within the community?






In 2018...

- 48 People were unsheltered.

Hometown: Kansas City, MO **Reason for Homelessness:** Lack of education and divorce.

Hometown: Chetopa, KS
Reason for Homelessness: Lack of rights
and opportunity after released from prison.



"People think I don't see it when they avoid eye contact or scoff at me. I see it, and it hurts." —Clint, age 46

Hometown: Lawrence, KS **Reason for Homelessness:** Visual impairments prevents him from finding adequate work.



"I am homeless, not hopeless. I will get back to the old Stephen some way or another." —Stephen Arnell, age 58

Hometown: Cleveland, OH **Reason for Homelessness:** Drug addiction and two divorces.
